All women's batch completes drone training in Pune at PBC's Aero Hub



Pune (Voice news service):- An all-women's batch including 19 members completed drone training program at PBC's Aero Hub at Saswad in Pune District. This is the first women's batch in Maharashtra to undergo drone training for medium drones (upto 50kg). The training was a part of the Indian Farmer's Fertilizer Cooperative Ltd IFFCO program for women under which they are being given a three wheeler electric vehicle as well as a drone set in an effort to boost rural development and women empowerment. The training program was conducted for 15 days. The certificates were handed over at a special function in presence of Mr. MS Pawar Senior Manager IFFCO along with directors of PBC's Aero Hub Anjali and Pranav Chitte.

In the training program recognized by DGCA, the participants underwent theoretical as well as practical training on operating drones. The topics included how to operate drones, rules and regulations, flying drones, use of drones in agriculture, types of fertilizers to be used. IoTech, one of the leading drone making companies also participated in program. PBC's Aero Hub incorporated in 2016 got a license for drone training from DGCA in March 2021. Till date 300 drone pilots and 100 instructors have been trained. Currently it is the only center in Maharashtra to be recognized by DGCA for instructor training. Those in the age group of 18-45 years with valid address proof documents are the eligible to participate in the program.

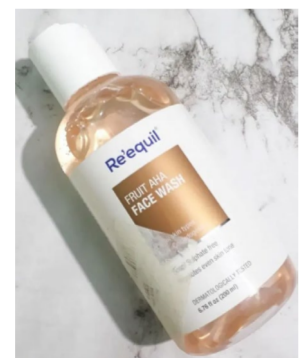

The event was also graced by Shri Atul Kumar Tiwari, Secretary, MSDE; Smt Trishaljit Sethi, DG, Directorate General of Training (DGT), Smt. Sonal Mishra, Joint Secretary, MSDE, Smt. Ishita Ganguli Tripathy, Additional Development Commissioner, MSME, Shri Ved Mani Tiwari, CEO, NSDC, Col. Mahendra Singh Payaai, Chief Program Officer, NSDC. Driven by the vision to make Guru-Shishya tradition more scalable, accessible and inno-

vative in its embodiment, artisans will be trained in modern tools, design elements and latest technologies to transform them into the master trainers. The scheme aims to preserve traditional skills, nurture entrepreneurial talent, market local products and augment socio-economic growth through such awareness programs and felicitations ceremony. The PM Vishwakarma Gurus can bring a lot of personal experience and learnings to those who can benefit from the scheme. By streamlining and expediting the orientation of these experts, the ministry envisions that the Gurus will become brand ambassadors of their respective trade under the PM Vishwakarma and help in creating awareness of the scheme at field level; further these Gurus can be onboarded as Master Trainers. To fuel further growth, collaborative efforts will be made to engage with skill training institutions like NIESBUD, ITIs, PMKK, PMKVY, UGC, CIPET and other centres to nurture the structured and outcome-driven training framework in India. Felicitating PM Vishwakarma Gurus, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Minister for Education and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship said, "It was great listening to the experiences of PM Vishwakarma Gurus. I express my gratitude to all the Vishwakarmas who thanked our

Hon'ble Prime Minister in writing. Each artisan and sculptor in Odisha is a Vishwakarma. Their creation is unique. We are going to focus on creating awareness and connect more of such artisans." There have been more than 17 lakh registrations on the PM Vishwakarma portal so far. The analysis of the applications received so far on the PM Vishwakarma portal underscores that the demand for skill training in the top 5 trades makes 80% of the application count. The top 5 trades in terms of applications in Odisha are- Mason, Tailor, Carpenter, Basket Maker/ Basket Weaver (Mat maker/ Coir Weaver/ Broom maker) and Potter. The ministry will also leverage the nationwide reach, and community expertise of CSCs to enhance registrations of trainers at regional level, while simultaneously preserve the traditional craft and promote them in contemporary contexts. The financial outlay from FY 2023-2024 to FY 2027-28 is ₹13,000 crore. The scheme aims to enhance the accessibility and quality of products and services offered by traditional artisans and craftsmen. The scheme offers collateral-free enterprise development loans of ₹1 lakh (first tranche to be repaid in 18 months) and ₹2 lakh (second tranche to be repaid in 30 months). A concessional rate of interest of 5% will be charged from the beneficiary, with interest subvention cap

of 8% to be paid by the Ministry of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises. The credit guarantee fees will be borne by the Central government. As a strategic step towards implementation of the PM Vishwakarma scheme, the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) also announced the commencement of the Training of Master Trainers & Assessors Program under PM Vishwakarma scheme, to empower artisans and craftsmen community in identified trades. The Master Trainers Training Programme aims to equip these master trainers with modern technology skills and entrepreneurial knowledge. Participants will receive training on entrepreneurial competencies, business plan preparation, the government support ecosystem, financial literacy, digital and social media marketing, branding, and marketing. Additionally, the master trainers will be provided with a modern tool kit to enhance their skills and adapt to contemporary practices. Indian artisans have played a vital role in India's economy. Mohammed Shami reveals why he never goes close to the pitch before the match in candid chat with PUMA

Pune (Voice news service):- Team India's dream run came to an end with a billion heartbreaks as Australia clinched their sixth title by securing a six-wicket victory in Ahmedabad on Sunday. The tournament's leading wicket-taker, pacer Mohammed Shami, set the tone with a fiery start, claiming David Warner on his very first ball. But despite this promising beginning, India couldn't seize the moment. Emerging as the most impressive sportsperson in the tournament with 24 wickets from eight games, including three impressive fifters, Shami's journey since 2015 has been nothing short of a movie script. Shami, who's also the PUMA brand ambassador, spoke his heart out in an extensive interview during his visit to the sports brand's headquarters in Bengaluru. "Nobody knew the pain I was dealing with [during the 2015 edition]," Shami confessed during a candid chat with PUMA as he revealed his success mantra of not taking a close look at the wicket before the start of the match, just to keep himself relaxed. In the exclusive interview, Shami also opened up

about various facets of his difficult yet impressive cricketing journey, right from scoring a century as an opener in his first leather ball match, earning money through cricket for the first time at around 16 years of age, overcoming personal challenges bravely, creating an old-school training set-up at farmhouse, to maiden India call-up and many more as the compelling interview was uploaded by PUMA on its YouTube channel today. "I had swelling in my knee before the 2015 tournament. Someone else could have said no but I have the ability to bear pain and I was told two options—either directly go for surgery or play the tournament and then go for the surgery. While the team would return to the hotel after every match, I would go to the hospital to take the injection. When you play for the country, you forget everything," Shami shared in the interview. Shami underwent a knee operation. "I was unconscious for two hours. When I woke up, I asked the doctor when I could start playing. He replied, 'It will be a big achievement if you walk without a limp, forget playing. It all

depends on how you go about your rehab," Shami said. Shami has not looked back since. His comeback journey has been visibly inspirational. He not only surpassed the likes of bowling greats to become the highest wicket-taker for the country in the world's biggest cricket tournament with 55 wickets from 18 matches, but also created history earlier in the semi-finals when he registered India's best ODI bowling figures of 7-57. The 33-year-old shared his secret that helps him perform better. "Generally, bowlers check the pitch after arriving at the ground. I never go close to the wicket because you will know how it behaves only when you bowl on it. Then why take the pressure? It's best to keep it simple, keep yourself relaxed and only then you will perform better," said Shami, as he also revealed that he doesn't follow any pre-match ritual. "Better hai aap subah utho, mast fresh hojao, chaay peeyo, gaane suno [it's better you wake up, get fresh, have tea and listen to songs]" he added. Talking about PUMA's revolutionary Let There



Be Sport initiative and the importance of sports culture in the country, Shami commented, "If the child has the talent, he should be supported. It's not necessary that every child will study and become an engineer or sit in top position. If your child is talented, he can reach greater heights in sports as well." Although Shami was in stellar form in the tournament, he had to sit out for the initial few matches. In the interview, he shared that it bothered him but the team's performance made him happy. "When you sit out for four matches, you need to be mentally strong. Sometimes you are under pressure but when you see the team performing well and going in a good direction, it gives you satisfaction." He added that he doesn't look at record books and only tries to take as many wickets as possible. Hard-coated brake disks

Pune (Voice news service):- Traffic gives rise to high levels of particulate emissions – especially in the cities. Too high, in the opinion of the EU Commission, which is pushing for significant reductions by introducing the Euro 7 emissions standard. Particulate emissions are caused primarily by abrasion in tires and brakes. An effective way to combat the emissions is therefore to use hard-coated brake discs which can reduce abrasion by up to 90 percent. However, manufacturing them poses special challenges for the grinding technology involved. The considerable time pressure being imposed by the new laws is making it particularly important to ensure that the process design and the resulting development partnerships are effectively coordinated. Nevertheless, this stress test for the sector could ultimately prove advan-

tageous, particularly now that investment is shifting towards electric vehicles. New materials increasing the complexity of the grinding process. Jannik Röttger explains the particular challenges involved in machining hard-coated brake discs. This September, he moved from a research position at RWTH Aachen University to Salach in southwest Germany as the new Head of Grinding Technology at Emag Maschinenfabrik: "Put simply, what hard-coated brake discs do in the grinding machine is exactly the same as what they do in a low-emission vehicle – create a powerful braking effect with no loss of material," says Röttger. "However, we need to achieve the exact opposite in the grinding process. The aim is to remove material in the shortest possible time in order to create the required geometry and surface properties."

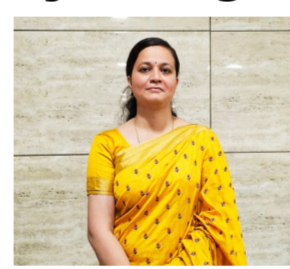
